Museum Center Visit

This is a free, one-hour program that can accommodate up to 60 students and adults. Reservations are required. Generally, students see a film and take a quick tour of the galleries. Your visit will include:

- Arkansas history video, *Echoes of the Past* (see description below)
- Group orientation about gallery manners and rules
- Self-guided tour of galleries (teachers and chaperones become guides for small groups of students). The museum provides a short "Gallery Search" hand-out to help with exploring the exhibits.

Four exhibit galleries – all on the first floor of the museum

Echoes of the Past, the film your students will see, runs about 20-30 minutes. A modern day child views the world of Arkansas Post from the 1680s to the 1860s. His grandfather explains about earlier times as the film dissolves to colorfully re-enacted scenes of Arkansas's Colonial, Revolutionary War and Civil War days.
