### **Museum Center Visit**

This is a free, one-hour program that can accommodate up to 60 students and adults. Reservations are required. Generally, students see a film and take a quick tour of the galleries. Your visit will include:

- Arkansas history video, Choose from film topics such as the *Middle Passage*, *Slavery in War Arkansas*, *the Dunbar Hunter Expedition* and *Arkansas Post, 1680s-1860s*.
- Group orientation about gallery manners and rules
- Self-guided tour of galleries (teachers and chaperones become guides for small groups of students). The museum provides a short "Gallery Search" hand-out to help with exploring the exhibits.
